Pentecost A:

The Holy Spirit Enters

Spread out the underlay. It has a well-defined square in the centre of a larger piece of felt, indicating the borders of the upper room. Place the backstand facing the children, at the end of the room closest to you. Close but <u>do not latch</u> the doors.

Acts 2:1-20 The Coming of the Holy Spirit

2 On the day of Pentecost all the Lord's followers were together in one place. Suddenly there was a noise from heaven like the sound of a mighty wind! It filled the house where they were meeting. Then they saw what looked like fiery tongues moving in all directions, and a tongue came and settled on each person there. The Holy Spirit took control of everyone, and they began speaking whatever languages the Spirit let them speak.

Many religious Jews from every country in the world were living in Jerusalem. And when they heard this noise, a crowd gathered. But they were surprised, because they were hearing everything in their own languages. They were excited and amazed, and said:

wall facing the children to move Peter into later.
